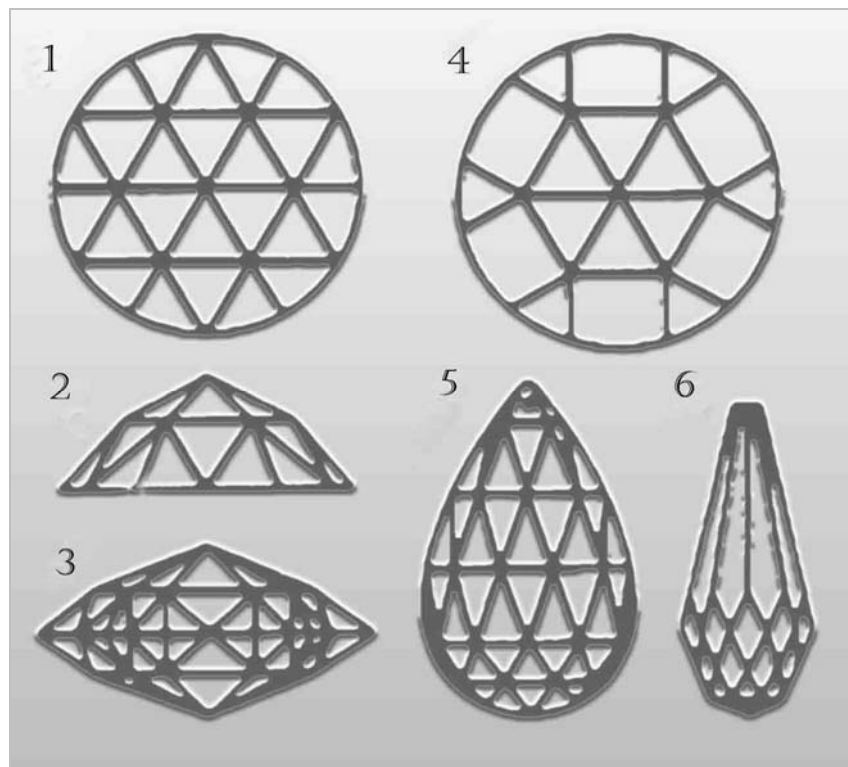
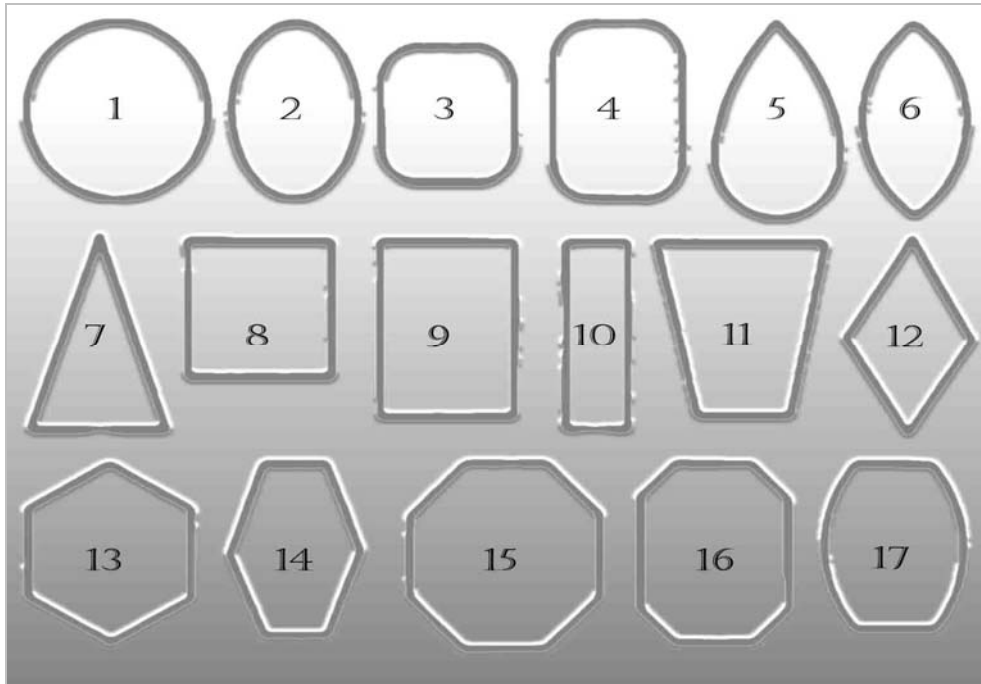

Six and eight-sided shapes:

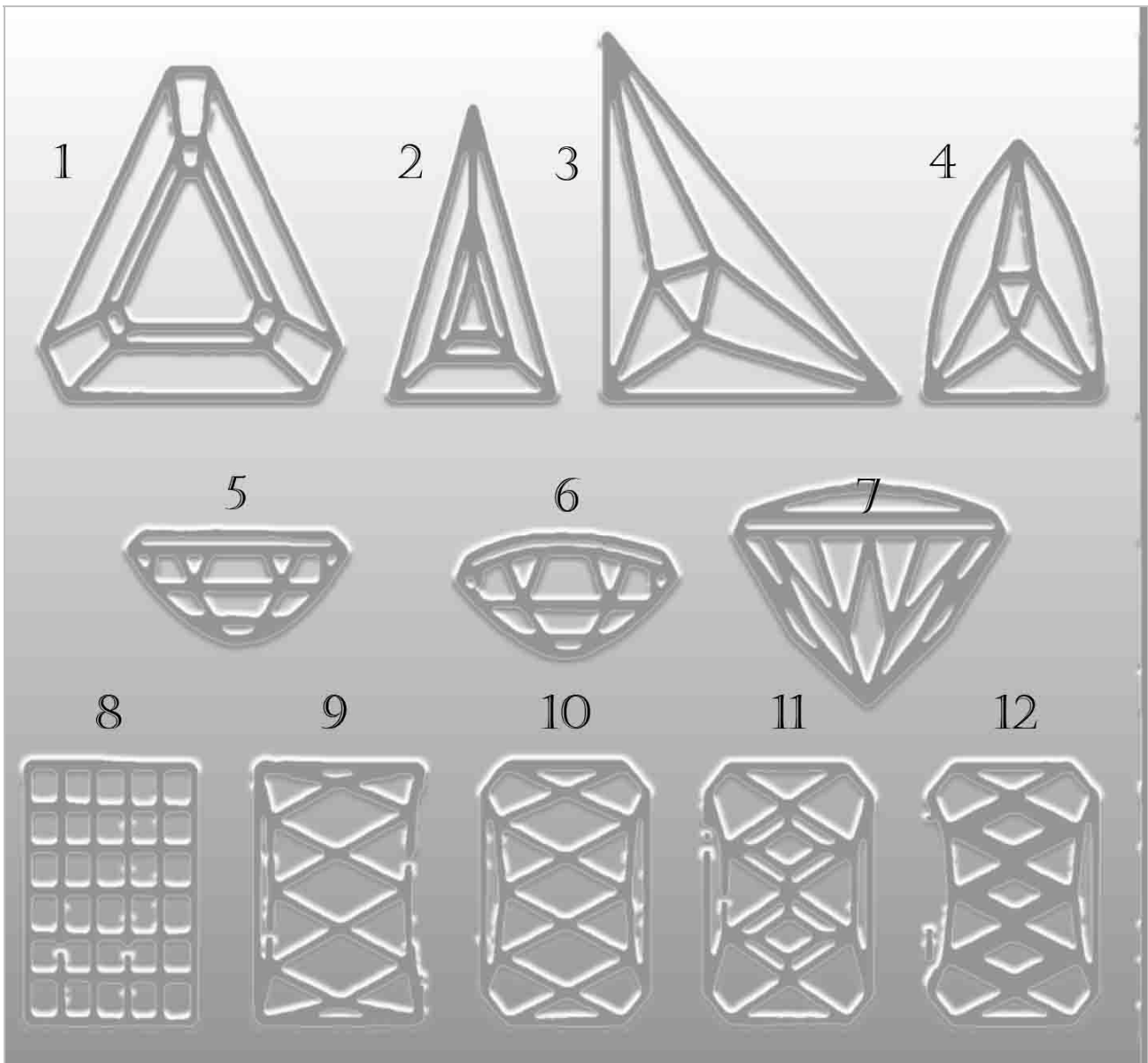

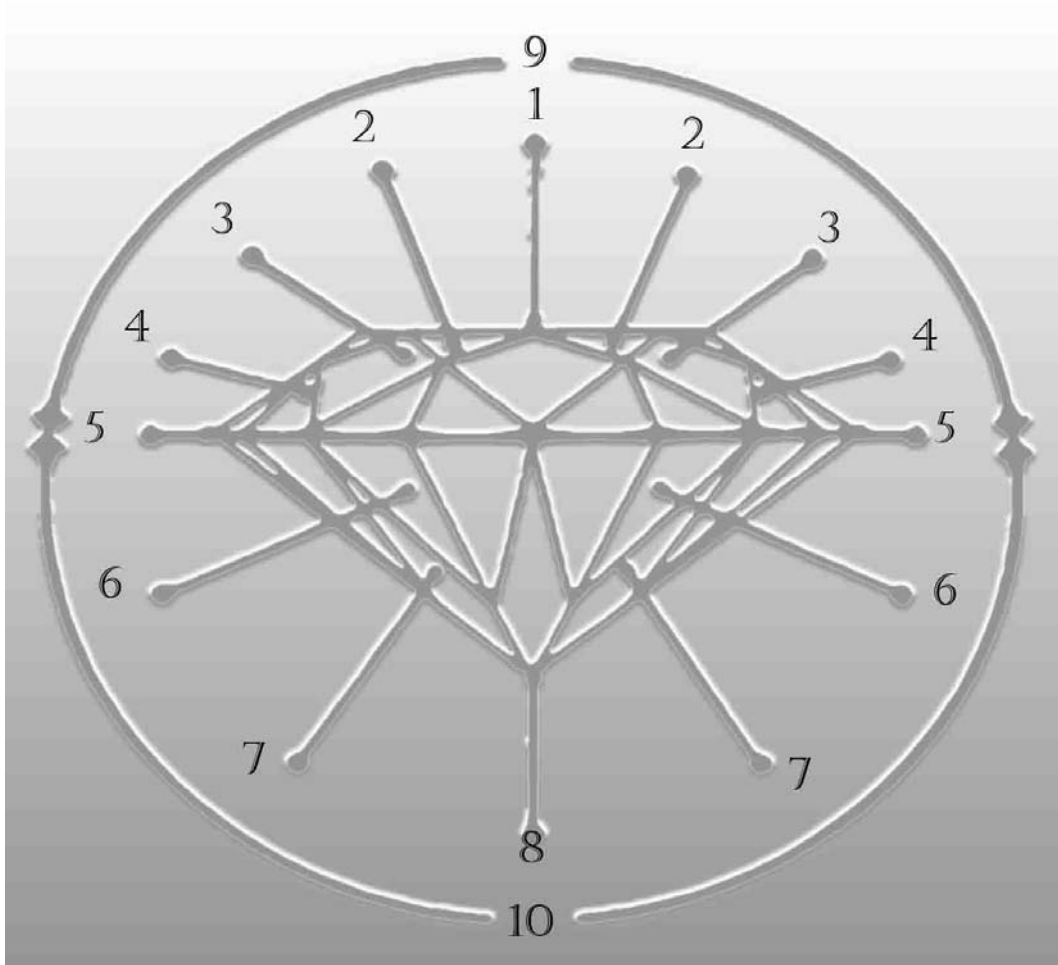

7. Buff top with brilliant-cut pavilion.
8. Chess cut
9. Bent-top.
10. Bent-top octagon, triangle.
11. Bent-top octagon, step triangle cut.
12. Bent-top octagon, step triangle cut.

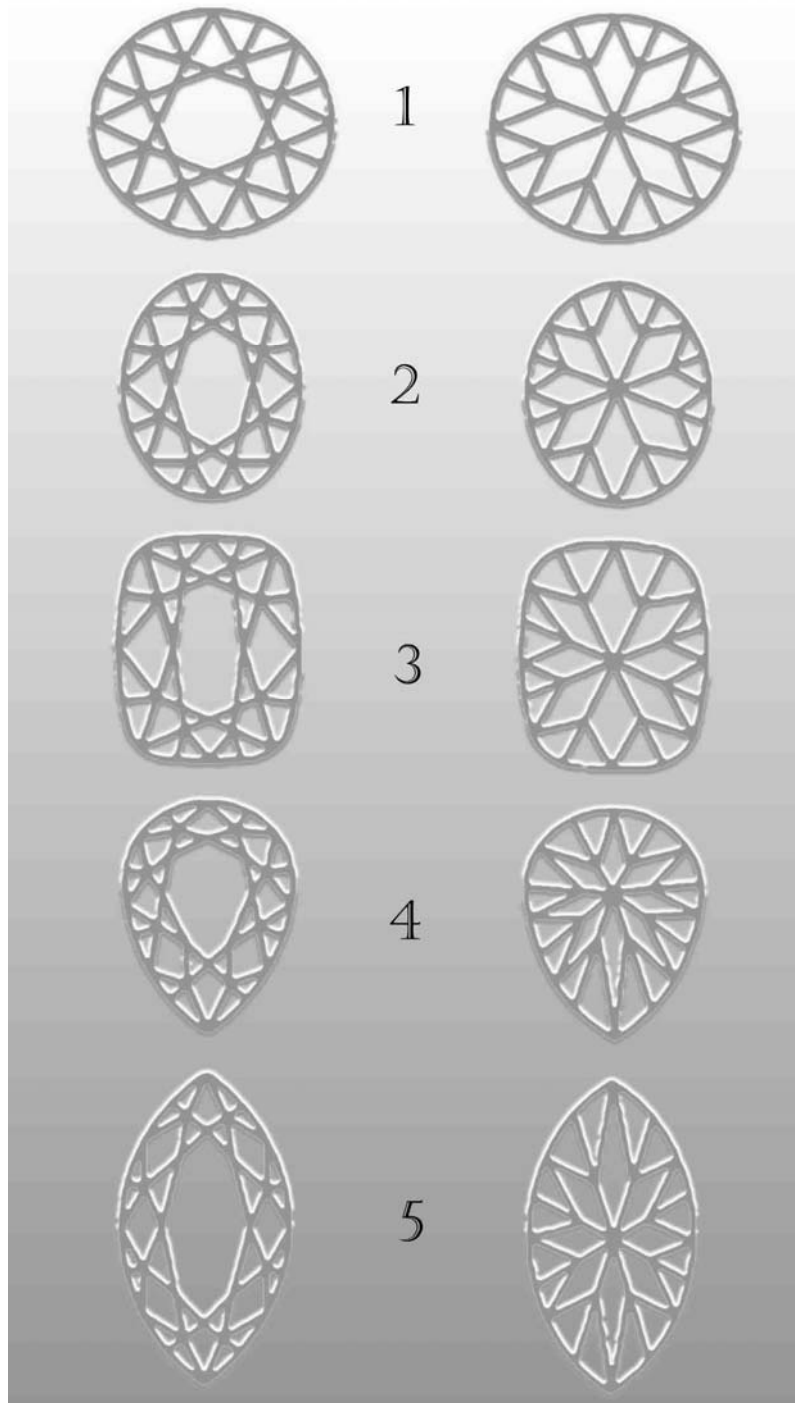


Parts of an American brilliant - cut diamond

8. Culet.

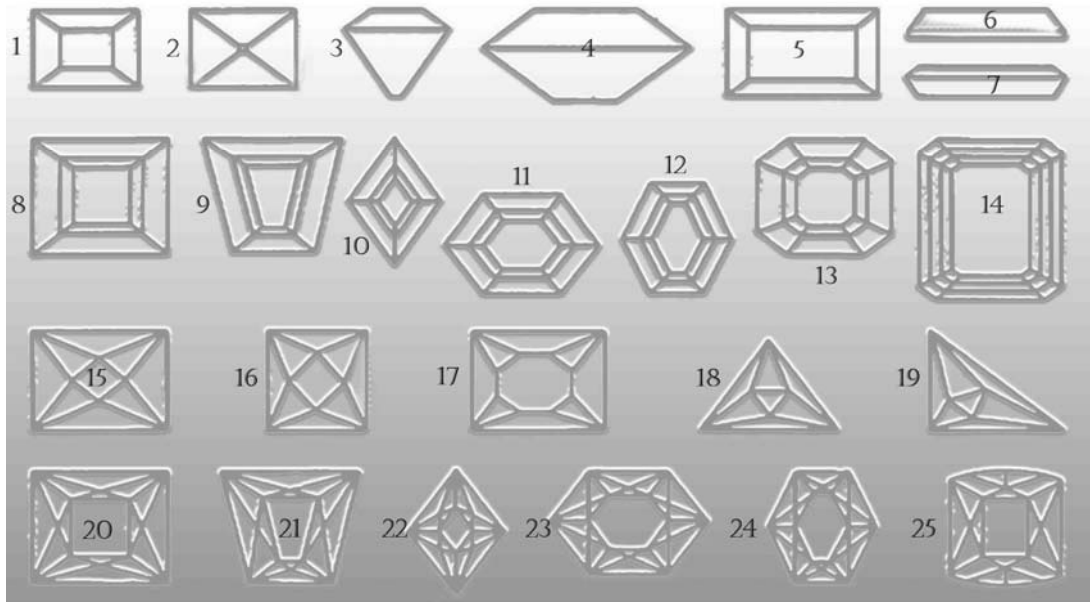

Stone cuts

1. Table cut, crown, octahedron diamond – crystal.
2. Table cut, pavilion with culet.
3. Table cut, side view.
4. Table cut, side view, another proportion.
5. Table cut, rectangle.
6. Table cut, crown bevel.
7. Table cut, crown and pavilion bevel.

STEP CUTS

8. Step cut, rectangle.
9. Step cut, trapeze.
10. Step cut, spear, or lozenge.

SIX - SIDED GIRDLES

11. Step cut, hexagon, round.
12. Step cut, long hexagon, oval.

EIGHT - SIDED GIRDLES

13. Step cut, octagon, emerald cut and two-crown steps.
14. Step cut, long emerald cut, three crown steps.

FRENCH CUTS

15. French cuts, square with square table.
16. French cuts, rectangle with lozenge table.
17. French cuts, square with octagonal table.
18. French cuts, equilateral triangle with equilateral table.

19. French cuts, right angle with isosceles triangle table.

CROSSCUTS

20. Crosscut, rectangle.

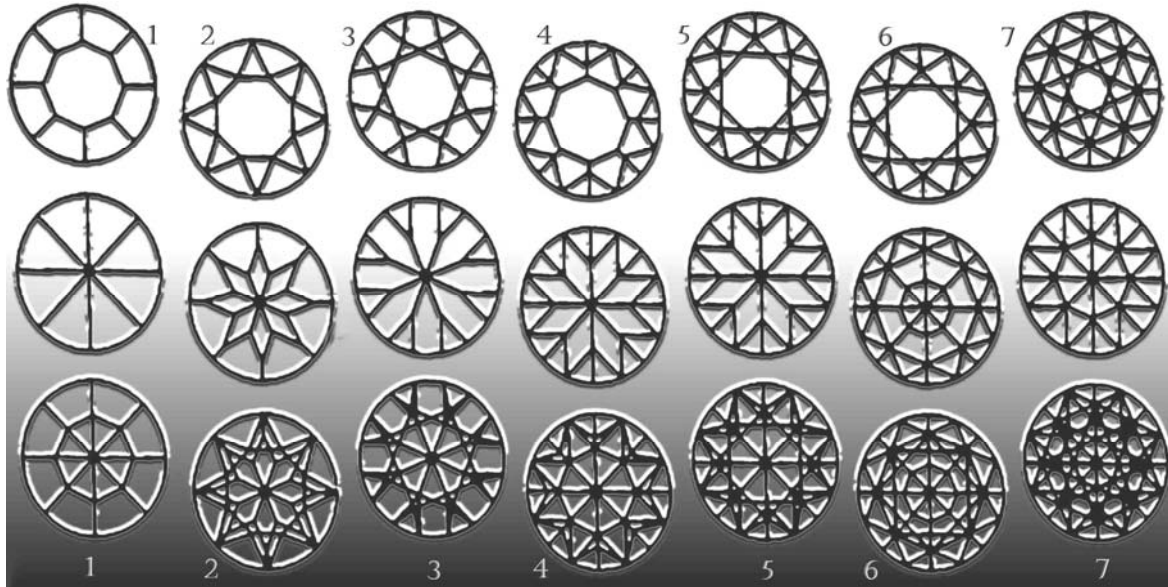
21. Crosscut, trapeze.

22. Crosscut, lozenge.

23. Crosscut, hexagon.

24. Crosscut, long hexagon.

25. Crosscut, pillow.
